Contributions may include, but are not limited to: identification, investigation and mediation of hazards; creation of effective prevention programs; insightful mishap investigation; and innovative safety program management. Contributions may also include activities in support of joint/coalition/federal flying operations.

Nomination narrative - Please submit for accomplishments in the past calendar year, limited to one page. One-page letters of endorsement are required from the MTF/CC or equivalent and flying Wing Chief of Safety, an additional one-page letter of endorsement may also be submitted. **Please combine all documentation into one PDF**. All submissions must be electronic, Times New Roman, 12 font.
